Regular worship is a critical component of confirmation class. Students should be worshiping with their families as well as attending class. Any of our three Sunday services qualify. Of course we hope you'll be there all 40 Sundays, but for half of those Sundays (ten each semester), we ask for students to fill out and turn in a "Sermon Notes" sheet. Our students find that this actually makes hearing a sermon easier! The note forms are available in class or online at *fpcbr.org*.



We'll have seven key memory verses, all from Scripture. They go along with what we're studying:

In addition, it is expected that by the end of the year each student will know the Lord's Prayer, The Apostles' Creed and how to quickly find the 66 books of the Bible.
