At least ten Sundays each semester: 20 total for the year.


Regular worship is a critical component of confirmation class. Students should be worshiping with their families as well as attending class. Any of our three Sunday services qualify. Of course we hope you'll be there all 40 Sundays, but for half of those Sundays, we ask students to fill out and turn in a "Sermon Notes" sheet.
