We have a great **TRADITION** here at First Presbyterian in our confirmation class. This is the class that prepares students for making a public profession of faith in Jesus Christ and thereby joining our church. Of course we hope you'll be there all 40 Sundays, but for half of those Sundays, we ask students to fill out and turn in a "Sermon Notes" sheet.
